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Purpose:

The purpose of this class is to help students learn Spanish as a second language while gaining an understanding of Spanish speaking cultures and traditions.

Did you know....

- * Spanish is spoken by 442 million people around the world (Wikipedia)
- * Spanish is the most spoken non-English language in the United States (Pew Research Center)
- * Hispanics are the biggest and fastest growing ethnic group in Utah (Utah Hispanic Chamber of Commerce)
- * The Hispanic population in Utah grew 78% during the past decade, growing by nearly 157,000 (Utah Hispanic Chamber of Commerce).

Understanding the rich culture and strong influence of the Spanish language will motivate the students to learn and instill in them the enthusiasm necessary to successfully acquire a second language.

Objectives:

To accomplish the goal of learning a new language the class will focus on the following objectives:

- * Participate in reading, learning letters, listening, singing, and speaking to communicate in Spanish.
- * Repeat Spanish vocabulary and learn/memorize key phrases.
- * Use meaningful classroom activities to engage with Spanish.

Class Rules:

Occasionally, vocabulary tests will be administered which will require the student to practice their Spanish words at home.
