Purpose and objectives:

In the process of study and practice, the students will meet the following four Visual Arts Core Standards: Creating Art, Presenting Art, Responding to Art and Connecting Art.

Expectations:

1. Students are expected to enter the art room with a readiness to participate, help others and to take care of the art room.
2. Respect yourself and others.
3. Listen and follow directions.
4. Clean up workspace.
5. Use appropriate language.

Consequences for infractions:

1. Verbal warning.
2. One-on-one conversation with the teacher and a call home.
3. Referral-parents will be notified.

Grades: Based on two categories

1. Major projects
2. Participation in class and/or small group discussions

Studio Hour: Tuesdays 3:20-4:30

Studio Hour is a designated time set for art students to come in the art room after school and work on projects/assignments. Studio hour is an opportunity for students to make-up work, add additional time into a project, or use materials that they may not have access to at home. This is also an opportunity for students to receive additional 1-on-1 instruction for projects.
